



LET NY VOTE

NEW YORKERS NEED FREE, FAIR AND SECURE VOTING. Unlike many other states, our antiquated laws discourage voting and deny citizens the freedom to vote. New York must be a leader in voting rights, not an excuse for voter suppression. Now is the time.



EARLY VOTING

Early Voting is needed to make voting equitable and accessible for all eligible New Yorkers. **It must include a minimum of 2 weekends and some evenings.** Funding should be included in the bill so it can pass before the budget session.



AUTOMATIC VOTER REGISTRATION

In New York, it is essential that Automatic Voter Registration is **implemented in governmental agencies not limited to the DMV** (e.g., Medicaid, etc).




FLEXIBILITY TO CHANGE PARTY AFFILIATION

New York has the most restrictive deadline in the country - **the change of party deadline must be shortened** to allow people to make an informed decision.



PERMANENTLY RESTORE VOTING TO PEOPLE ON PAROLE

Restoring voting rights for people on parole needs to be codified in law, so **restoration is automatic and does not require additional steps other than to re-register.** It must include and fund implementation, education, information and directions in alternative formats. This is the first step toward ensuring that New Yorkers incarcerated for a felony conviction never lose the right to vote.



CONSOLIDATED PRIMARIES

New York is the only state with two primaries, which is confusing for voters and a waste of taxpayer money. It's time for New York to act responsibly and hold **one primary for congressional and state offices, preferably in June.**



SAME DAY REGISTRATION

It's time to **amend New York's constitution to allow Same Day Registration** to boost our woefully low voter turnout and allow voters to correct inaccuracies or make changes in their voter registration when they go to vote.



READABLE, WELL-DESIGNED BALLOTS

New York needs legible, clear ballots. **The Voter Friendly Ballot Act**, written in consultation with specialists in the fields of graphic design, user experience, and disability accommodation amongst others, should become law in 2019.
